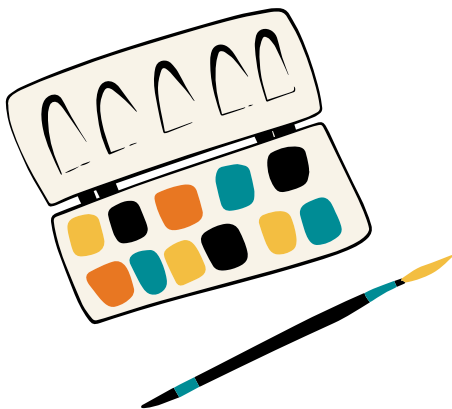

STEAM Academy Youth Workshops

STEAM Academy is offering a **FREE workshop for middle school aged youth during April vacation week!** Students will explore **Frog Morphology**, looking at different frog species to see how the process of natural selection has led to the variations that we see on Earth today. During the lessons, students will watch videos by Harvard scientists and examine printed and virtual 3D frog models from the Harvard Museum of Comparative Zoology Herpetology Collection, to learn about frog diversity, physical characteristics, and development. **This is a 5-day course that will be held virtually via Zoom.**

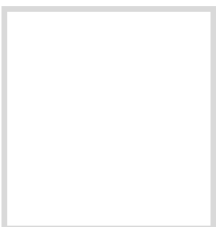
