Come join Resident Services as we plant native plants in our pots out front of the community center.

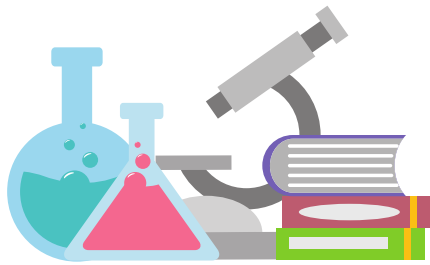
